Thoughts from the Vice President

Hello everyone,

I have a few items I would like to share with you for consideration as we end 2023 and head into 2024. As vice president one of my roles is to help facilitate the board elections each year. This generally happens in March or April. Our board can consist of up to 12 members and typically we target having a minimum of 8-10. We strive for the board to be diverse – consisting of both parents and members of the LGBTQ+ community. We also strive to have representation of members with different experiences (e.g. parents of gay, trans and non-binary youth, as well as children of parents in the LGBTQ+ community, etc.)



This election year will be special as our president and I will step down after 4 years in our roles and we expect several of our current board members may choose to roll off as their terms conclude. I am including this here to let you know there will be change and to seek your support in identifying both members for the board and members for these officer roles. Rosemary and I are both parents of gay children. Ideally, as the greatest growth in our chapter has been in supporting families with Trans Youth, we would love to have our chapter's new leaders represent this sector of our support.

Board member candidates need to be members of the chapter, agree to attend the board meetings, and attend at least one support group monthly.

Personally, I still plan to pursue staying on the board, co-facilitating our Spanish-speakers Estamos Contigo support group, participating in PFLAG National's "PFLAG en Español" meetings, and developing the content for our bi-monthly newsletter to all of you. Recent and Upcoming PFLAG San Jose/Peninsula Activity in the Community

November and December were quieter months for chapter activities in the community and that usually continues into January and February. While there were no tabling events to provide information on PFLAG, Karen attended one day of Somos Familia's "Encuentro de Familias y Diversidad" 2-day program in Oakland, CA over the weekend of 12/2-12/3/23.

Somos Familia was founded by two moms from the East Bay (San Francisco Bay Area) with Latino gay and bisexual sons in 2007 to reach out to other families. The weekend program held both general sessions for all participants and more focused conversations in smaller workshops. The focus on intergenerational experience and exchange that the program fostered throughout the day was wonderful. It was a great opportunity to see how another well-established organization is supporting the Latinx members of our LGBTQ+ community and I hope to establish stronger links to their work in the future that could help us grow and evolve our Estamos Contigo support group. It is important we work together to help the community. After the workshop, I visited their website and located a beautiful short documentary where three Latina immigrant mothers talk about the coming out stories of their children and their unconditional love and support for them. <u>Here is the link</u> (there are English subtitles available).



REMINDER: eQuality Collaborative Scholarship Opportunity Applications are <u>Due January 31, 2024</u>



The eQuality Scholarship Collaborative awards scholarships to honor and encourage California students for their service to the lesbian/gay/bisexual/transgender community.

Our PFLAG SAN Jose/Peninsula Chapter participates in this Collaborative and in 2023 granted seven scholarships.

Eligibility:

- In general, eligible students fall into one of these categories: Resident of northern or central California who completed or expects to complete high school or equivalent between 1 Jul 2019 and 30 Jun 2024;
- Resident of northern or central California who completed or expects to complete community college between 1 Jul 2019 and 30 Jun 2024;
- LGBT+ graduates of Oakland Unified School District high schools;
- Students pursuing a medical degree at an accredited medical school in California
